



A learning community in the metaverse for media and information literacy of adults

About the project

ALIVE project aims to foster media, information and digital literacy (MIL) of citizens and raise awareness of its importance in today's fast-paced, globalised society where we have easy access to incredible amounts of information, especially online. In addition, it will provide learning opportunities and an innovative platform to improve the MIL competences of adults over 45 years old, who have fewer learning opportunities in this field. These are the main objectives of the ALIVE project, a learning community in the metaverse for media and information literacy of adults, co-funded by the Erasmus+ programme of the European Union.



The project

Six EU organisations form the AliVE project consortium: GTN Global Training Network GmbH (Austria); TUS Technological University of the Shannon: Mindlands Midwest (Ireland); CSI Center for Social Innovation LTD (Cyprus); ALTERA VITA Social Cooperative Enterprise of Cyclades (Greece); FEMXA Formación S.L.U. (Spain); Lascò Srl (Italy).

With the goal of improving learning opportunities for adults through innovation in education, these organisations (SMEs, HEIs, and NGOs) will develop a MIL Methodological Framework for adults over 45, and a metaverse-based elearning platform and learning resources to improve media, information and ICT/digital literacy of learners in an interactive learning experience.



Current Status



After our project's kick-off in **Linz**, **Austria**, in the first days of December, we started the development of the <u>Methodological Framework in MIL:</u>

 we identified the competences to be included in the Framework and the competence assessment tool for adults;

Current Status

 we developed and launched an assessment tool to assess the information and media literacy competences of adults in digital environments and their ICT/digital competences, based on the DigiComp 2.2. Framework of the EU, and other relevant European frameworks;



- we will assess the competences of 240 adults aged 45+ with the assessment tool developed in https://comet.edustandards.org/;
- we will develop the ALiVE Methodological Framework in MIL with recommendations for adults over 45, incorporating the feedback from the assessment results;
- we will validate the Methodological Framework with learners and educators through guided interviews.
